2011-09-04	<p>Cornwall Council Matters: Cllr. Lugg gave members an update of business within Cornwall Council. He also reported that the One Stop Shop in Camelford would soon be moving into the library.</p> <p>Cllr E Jones asked Cllr. Lugg (Parish Councillor and Cornwall Councillor, on the CC planning committee) where his allegiance lay when he knew his Parish Council was opposed to a planning application and he was then required to vote at the planning committee of CC in favour of granting such an application? Councillor Lugg replied that CC expected him to vote according to his personal preference on such matters.</p> <p>Cllr. Jones asked Cllr. Lugg to ascertain if any new/ special rules would be imposed on PCs by CC which would need to be taken into consideration prior to this Council setting the 2012/13 precept.</p>	JL
2011-09-05	<p>Cemetery: Cllrs E. Jones and A. Hopkins would seek an appointment to meet with Colin Davey during week beginning September 12th to open negotiations for the purchase of land into which to extend the cemetery.</p>	E.H & A.H.
2011-09-06	<p>Footpaths: It was reported that Cornwall Council had agreed to reimburse this Council for work carried out on the local footpath network. No complaints had been received about the condition of any footpath. Cllr E Jones was pleased to report that the footpath through Little Delanuth had now been cleared of obstructions, this following the intervention of the footpath officer at Cornwall Council.</p>	
2011-09-07	<p>Delabole Youth Council: Cllr. Boardman told members that the BMX track was now officially open but further works to improve the surface would be carried out in due course following the advice contained within the post installation inspection (required by the Insurance Co) A profit of £80.40 had been made on the BBQ and had been paid into the fundraising account. Further fundraising events were planned to assist with the future costs which would be incurred. The thanks of this council were to be extended to Cllr A Stacey, Mr A. Hopkins, Mr. Shore for the sound system, John Theobald, Jo Nethercot, Maria and Colin Gameson for the help they gave at the BBQ that helped to make the day such a success.</p>	
2011-09-08	<p>Correspondence: The Chairman had met with the Clerk prior to this meeting and updated himself with all correspondence sent and received. A précis of these would be offered to Councillors unless they requested a reading of the full text. A letter had been received from St John's Church requesting a grant towards costs of graveyard upkeep. It was decided to offer them a donation as no grant faculty had been set aside in this financial year. £300 to St John's and £300 to St Tetha with a further £150 to St Teath Methodist Chapel. This course of action was proposed by Cllr. A Stacey, seconded by Cllr. G Boardman and agreed to unanimously. The street names Koth Karrji and Bruallen Close had been re ordered by the clerk as CC had failed, so far, to put them in place despite the signs having been ordered on 16th February 2011 (according to CC)</p>	
2011-09-09	<p>Matters of Public Interest: It was agreed that, in future, a meeting should be held in August. Proposed by Cllr E Jones and seconded by Cllr J Tidd and carried unanimously. Cllr A Hopkins suggested this extra meeting should always be held in Delabole. This action would keep all other meetings at the alternate venues as is the case at present, in this way the December meeting would always be St</p>	

<p>2011-09-10</p>	<p>Teath one year and Delabole the next. Agreed. Active Partnering, with specific ref. to Public Conveniences, to be discussed at next meeting. The provision set aside for the benefit of Delabole residents at the re powering of Delabole Wind Farm was discussed. The annual benefice from Good Energy is to be in the control of The Delabole Development Group. Plans for Jubilee celebration to be discussed at next meeting.</p> <p>Meetings Attended: The clerk had attended the Area Branch Meeting of the Society of Local Council Clerks (at Bodmin Town Council Offices) and Concessionary Bus Fares Inquiry (County Hall, Truro.) A hard copy report on both had been supplied to Councillors. Cllr P Hicks had attended a Credit Union meeting. The merge with Redruth Credit Union would soon be completed. Cllr E Jones was now on the panel of The Friends of Camelford Leisure Centre at which plans were being formulated to save the centre from closure.</p>
