	<p>Apologies: Cllrs. P. Hicks, G. Boardman. Cllr. Lugg at Leisure Centre meeting. Alteration required to Minutes dated 16th May 2011. Mr Simon Edwards wished it be recorded that the purpose of his attendance at the public session was to speak to councillors about the two houses currently being built on land adjoining his property in Treroosel Road, and not the state of the roads around The Meadows, as stated in the minutes.</p> <p>Minutes: Acceptance of the minutes was proposed by Cllr. A Hopkins, seconded by Cllr. G Aston.</p> <p>Matters Arising: It was reported that the consultation, carried out by leaflet drop, in Trehannick, Valley View and Bryny Close had produced inconclusive answers as to the future of the mobile library in this area of St Teath. Replies received, 1 for and 1 against.</p>	
2011-07-01	<p>Planning Applications: PA11/03663. Revised access details (application no. E1/2009/01353 dated 18/11/09 for Construction of two storey detached house refers) 115, Pengelly, Delabole. No viable reason given for this alteration to the access. Council did not support the application. PA11/05147. Replacement of garage with garage/summerhouse. Atlantic View, Treligga. Delabole. Decision held over to accommodate site visit by members of Planning Committee. Subsequent decision received, Council did not support this application as it was felt such a development would not be in keeping with other properties in this conservation area. Decision Received. PA11/03755. Alteration to side entrance to create larger door opening. 14, Rosewater Park, St Teath. Approved (in line with PC decision)</p>	
2011-07-02	<p>Contractor: It was reported that the playhouse in Delabole Playing Field was in need of extensive repairs and that the manufacturers had been informed. The contractor had worked his required hours and all work around the Parish was up to date.</p>

2011-07-05	<p>Delabole Cemetery: Having spoken to Mr Davey, Cllr. Hopkins was of the opinion that he would have no objection to this Council seeking a revised valuation on the land in Vell Lane.</p>	Clerk.
2011-07-06	<p>Public Footpaths: All footpaths and stiles had now received the first cut and the contractor's invoice was scheduled for payment at this meeting. Copy documents and request for part payment of grant from Cornwall Council were ready to be sent to County Hall.</p> <p>It was noted that the 'kissing gate' onto footpath in Trevilley Lane was now undersize since a repair had been carried out. The landowner, Mr Cornelius, to be written to and requested to reinstate at full size.</p> <p>The clerk reported that Cornwall Council had taken action to reopen footpath through Little Delanuth. Chris Monk was in contact with the landowner, Mr Anderson. Ref: Minute 2011-05-06.</p>	Clerk. Clerk.

2011-07-07	<p>Delabole Youth Council: Two quotes had been received for fencing around BMX track. It was decided that 2.4m high would be the most suitable for which, it was expected, planning permission should be sought. The quote from Superior Fencing to be accepted. Proposed by Cllr G Keat, seconded by Cllr. A Hopkins. Agreed.</p> <p>Plans for the official opening on August 6th were agreed and all Councillors asked to attend if possible. Cllr. G. Boardman and the clerk would have a meeting with members of The Youth Council on Wednesday, 20th July to set out 'ground rules' for the future of the BMX track and arrange for volunteers to help at the opening.</p>	
2011-07-08	<p>Correspondence: A copy of the letter sent to Councillor Lance Kennedy had been e-mailed to all Councillors. Minute 2011-06-09, Matters of Public Interest, applies. No reply received thus far.</p> <p>Councillors were invited to attend the official opening of Quarry View, Delabole on Tuesday, 26th July 2011. Opening to be performed by Cllr. Mark Kaczmarek.</p> <p>A letter of thanks had been received from St Teath Community Bus Appeal for this Council's donation of £500 to the fund.</p>	Reply received 24.7.11.
2011-07-09	<p>Matters of Public Interest: Thanks were extended to Cllr. A Stacey and the Carnival Committee for the excellent way in which the Delabole Carnival had been planned and run with minimum anti social behaviour being experienced and an enjoyable time had by all who attended.</p> <p>Cllr. Hopkins reported that exchange of contracts on land at The Sidings would take place on August 6th. It was expected that the contract to build would be issued soon after this date and construction of 'affordable housing' would start shortly.</p> <p>Cllr. Stacey reported overgrown trees on the road to Treligga and a 'Give Way' sign being repeatedly repainted despite this section of road being designated as a 'no entry'.</p> <p>The Clerk wished to investigate the possibility of starting a 'Village Warden' scheme in the Parish with special attention to recruiting volunteers in Delabole to patrol after dark at known trouble spots. This proposal put forward in light of police cut backs. Clerk to gather more information.</p> <p>Clerk asked Cllr Stacey to take responsibility for day to day maintenance of Delabole Millenium Clock. He would give this consideration.</p> <p>Clerk reported the success of the initiative to supply garden waste sacks from her office to local shops and residents rather than people having to access the OSS in Camelford.</p>	.
