2010-09-05	<p><b>Quality Council:</b> The Clerk had now attended both training sessions in preparation for her Society of Local Council Clerks portfolio of evidence.</p>	
2010-09-06	<p><b>Delabole Youth Council:</b> Cllr. G. Boardman, Chairman DYC, told Council of more fundraising events planned. Saturday, Sept. 26<sup>th</sup>, Car Wash at R&amp;M Motors, Saturday, October 9<sup>th</sup>, Sponsored cycle ride along The Camel Trail from Wadebridge to Padstow. M&amp;R Motors would transport cycles to Wadebridge, volunteers would be sought to transport riders to and from this event. Sponsorship forms would be available in local shops and businesses. £1469.75 had so far been raised towards the construction of the BMX Track.</p>	
2010-09-07	<p><b>Delabole Cemetery:</b> Cllr. J. Lugg expressed his intention of speaking to Ian Thompson, CC, with reference to the purchase of additional land into which to extend Vell Lane Cemetery but Councillors were of the opinion that this could cause possible confusion and that the Clerk should be instructed to continue her dialogue with Philip Jones, CC, to set up an urgent meeting with the Land owner as only approx. 20 spaces were now available. It would very soon become critical and space would have to be 'rationed' with no more grave spaces being 'sold in advance'. The situation brought about by the landowner's procrastination and refusal to enter into meaningful discussion, despite an offer having already been made, had presented this Council with an urgent need to secure this extension or seek land elsewhere in which to open a new cemetery.</p>	Clerk.
2010-09-08	<p><b>Playing Fields/The Green:</b> It appeared that now St Teath Playing Field had been cut by a person in the private sector, Cornwall Council had apparently lost interest in this piece of land, and a long term solution must be sought for the future grass cutting of this play area. The Clerk would again contact the Area Network Manager and request that he reopen discussions as to funding for this operation in the future. The Chairman was of the opinion that £1000 should be included in next years' precept to cover the cost of cutting this area by this Council's contractor.</p>	Clerk.
